District/Authority Awards are \$1,250 awards intended to reward students for excellence in seven non-academic fields. These scholarships are meant to assist towards tuition costs for furthering students' post-secondary education.

Criteria

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident (landed immigrant)
- Meet graduation requirements
- Have had good attendance, punctuality, work habits and cooperation.
- Meet the criteria determined by the Elgin Park Scholarship Committee, which requires a student to

demonstrate superior achievement in one of the following areas:

- o Indigenous Languages and Culture, demonstrated at school or in the community
- **Fine Arts** (e.g., Visual Arts, Dance, Drama, Music, Photography)
- **Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies** (e.g., Business Ed, Technology Ed, Home Economics, Information Communication Technology)
- **Physical Activity** (e.g., Athletics, Dance, Gymnastics, not limited to Physical Education)
- International Languages from the International Languages curriculum or External Assessments. Languages mush have been learned as part of a students' education.
- Community Service (Volunteer Activity), which includes awareness of local, global, and cultural issues
- **Technical and Trades Training** (e.g., Carpentry, Automotive, Mechanics, Coop & Apprenticeship Programs)

Students must redeem the voucher within five years from Sept. 30th of their graduating year from Elgin Park, before the expiry date stated on the voucher.
